Important Info about dialing 911

When you call 911 from any campus phone or your cellular phone you will be connected to Corvallis Emergency dispatch.

Dispatch will not automatically know your location: provide this information immediately.

Trust your instincts! If you think you need help, make the call.

When you are helping a student in distress:

- Be aware of the location of the nearest phone, whether it is in the building or a personal cell phone
- If the student is causing a disruption but does not pose a threat:
 - * Discuss the situation with the student to address the inappropriate behavior.
 - * If the problem continues, ask the disruptive student to leave.
 - * If they refuse to leave, call Public Safety at 541-737-3010.
- **If you are concerned for your safety or that of others call 911 immediately.**

Emergency loan	Emergency loans are short term loans of up to \$350.00. To be eligible to receive an emergency loan students must be enrolled at least half-time, be degree-seeking, and not have any active financial holds.
