## Step One

APPLY FOR ADMISSION AT OSU  
<http://oregonstate.edu/admissions>  
When you receive your letter of admission and your student ID number, go to step two.

## Step Two

START YOUR VA BENEFITS  
Go to [www.benefits.va.gov/gibill](http://www.benefits.va.gov/gibill) to apply for educational benefits. After receiving your Certification of Eligibility, submit a copy to the veterans certifying official located in the Office of the Registrar, B102 Kerr Administration Building.

If you have used benefits prior to OSU then fill out a 22-1995 Change of Place of Training Form on the VA website. When it has been processed a new Certification of Eligibility will be issued to you.

If you are unsure of benefits available to you, please contact the certifying officials in the Registrar's Office.



# Apply for Financial Aid

## Step Three
