- **General Coronavirus Updates:** Please continue to stay informed by checking the [COVID-19 Information](#) on the OSU homepage. This is an evolving matter in which things can change quickly. You can access information shared with fraternity/sorority leadership by [clicking here](#).
  - Keep in mind the updated requirements from Governor Brown regarding facecoverings outdoors and the limit on 10 people for gatherings. Read the full details here: <https://www.oregon.gov/newsroom/Pages/NewsDetail.aspx?newsid=36940>
  - **Fall 2020 Planning:** I know our chapters are eager to begin planning for the resumption of in person activities and to return to some type of normal. As you consider your plans, keep the following things in mind that will likely be in place for fall term:
    - Facecoverings will be required in situations where social distancing can't adequately occur (hallways, elevators, offices, classrooms, student events, etc.)
    - Classes of 50 and below will be in person (in most cases), classrooms will be outfitted for Zoom capabilities
    - UHDS move-in will occur over several days to reduce density and volunteers will be unable to participate
    - First year live-on requirement will be in effect, students can apply for exemptions
    - Welcome Week plans are underway, and will be delivered in a predominantly virtual format

- Chapter events, philanthropies, etc. can expect to have capacity limits, social distancing expectations, facecoverings required, no buffets/food service (to-go only), etc.
- Anticipate that fall chapter meetings will be hosted virtually (amongst other events)
- Several fall sports have announced that only Pac12 games will be played (including football)
- Classes will not meet in person after Thanksgiving, students will be encouraged to stay where they are if they travel home/elsewhere/away from campus

Finally, look for an email from me in the coming weeks to schedule another Zoom call so we can connect further as a housed chapter community. Don't hesitate to let me know if you need anything else at this time!
