- Alex Gowen, VP Recruitment, will be in contact with all of your recruitment chairs and will inform them that all COB events have been postponed until the University reevaluates the risk of COVID-19.

- **Other Information**

- **All University SING:** At this time, all SING practices, meetings, and reviews have been suspended until further notice. Information regarding the final performance will be communicated at a later date.
- **2020 Relationship Statement:** Please work with your chapter coach to navigate any 2020 Relationship Statement criteria your chapter will not be able to complete during this time. The CFSL will work with chapters on a case by case basis to resolve these matters.
- The CFSL will remain open over Spring Term, but all meetings with advisors will take place via zoom.
